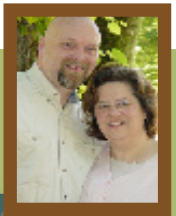

We spent three days at a local Madrid church evangelizing the neighborhood's kids. The pastor told us that 80% of the people in their church that weekend were NOT regular church people. The Sunday following our Kid's Quest campaign, twelve kids were waiting at the church door for church to begin. That is significant growth for that church.
